- 4. If Regional Facilities are to be extended to serve the property, a financial commitment by the Applicant for the expenditures incurred for construction thereof.
- 5. If the Applicant is proposing to include the property in the District, a description of all land owned by Applicant that is contiguous to the property and a petition for inclusion including remittance of an amount set by the District to pay for inclusion costs.
- 6. Other submissions as the District may reasonably require for evaluation of the application.

H. AGREEMENT

The applicant agrees and acknowledges that use under the permit must be as limited and defined by applicable law and the Strasburg Sanitation & Water District Rules and Regulations with Design Standards. The applicant bears sole responsibility for compliance with and knowledge of the Rules and Regulations and understands that violation of such can result in legal action and remedies being assessed against the applicant. Connection to, or any other use of, District Facilities without prior approval and acceptance of this application will be prosecuted to the fullest extent allowed. Submission of this application does not vest any right or claim to service in applicant. The District reserves the right to deny any application for service.
